

## **JULIETA RAMOS-ELORDUY, PhD.**

Dr. Julieta Ramos-Elorduy B is senior researcher at the Institute of Biology of the University of México (UNAM). Her research focuses on edible insects of Mexico and of the world, and also on medicinal insects and insects as recyclers.

Author of the books, *Insects as a Source of Proteins in the Future*, *Edible Insects in Ancient Mexico*, *Creepy Crawly Cuisine* and *Medicinal Insects*. Dr. Ramos-Elorduy has also published 92 scientific articles, 48 chapters in diverse scientific books, with 5 in press. She has participated in 345 international and national congresses.

Dr. Ramos-Elorduy is also Founder of the Mexican Society of Ethnobiology, Chair of Insect Physiology Faculty of Sciences, Prix Martin de la Cruz International Society of Traditional Medicine and Prix Juana de Asbaje as academic recognition given by UNAM.

She is referee of the *Journal of Ecology and Food Nutrition*, *Journal of Food Composition and Analysis*, *Journal of Ecology of Ethnobiology and Ethnomedicine*, *Journal of Sustainable Development*, *Interciencia*, *LACITO*, *Environment, Development and Sustainability*, *Sitentibus*, and also several national scientific reviews, among them: *Acta Zoológica Mexicana*, *Folia Entomológica*, *Revista Mexicana de Biodiversidad*. She has also been a consultant to many government and private institutions.

Dr. Ramos-Elorduy has directed 56 pregrade degree theses and 12 Masters of Science and Ph. D. pupils, and has dictated 50 national and international chairs about entomology, insects physiology, insect ethnology, edible insects and their nutritive value, medicinal insects, recycle insects and insect in animal nutrition, etc. and conducted 126 seminars
